Guidelines for Submitting Articles to the *Forum*

All submissions to the *Forum* must be in electronic format: e-mail, 3.5" PC-formatted disk, or PC-formatted Iomega Zip 100 disk. We prefer Microsoft Word documents, however, WordPerfect and ASCII text files are also acceptable. Please adhere to the following additional guidelines when submitting your article(s):

- ✓ E-mail submissions will only be accepted with an ATTACHED document file—*do not* embed the file in your e-mail as we will be unable to use it. Your e-mail program should have an option to attach a file. When e-mailing an article, also be sure to attach any graphic files as well.
- ✓ If you are mailing your article, please submit both a hard copy of the article(s) AND a disk with the article and any graphic files (TIFF, JPEG) copied onto it. Before mailing, please be sure that your article did in fact copy onto the disk.
- ✓ Any artwork, photos, or figures that are referenced to in your article must be enclosed with your mailed submission or scanned and on the disk in either TIFF or JPEG format. Any graphics that are submitted for scanning must be clean, original copies. Supplied graphics should be embedded in the document AND sent as separate attached files (or placed individually on disk).
- ✓ Please submit clean originals and clear photos. If you need artwork, graphics, or photos returned, please supply a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your submission and they will be returned promptly.

Live Workshop 2000 • March 1–5 • Orlando, Florida

The ISHRS is pleased to announce its official support of the World Hair Society's Sixth Annual Live Workshop, March 1–5, 2000. The two societies have mutual goals and believe in providing strong educational opportunities for the hair restoration community. They are convinced a combined relationship will best serve the hair restoration community.

The Live Workshop format offers more than 18 live surgeries covering a comprehensive range of technology, techniques, and patients. Surgeons are provided the opportunity to observe, and at times participate, inside the Operating Rooms and work with the leading experts in the field. This proximity fosters a unique interchange of information and learning process. A scientific program featuring comparative research studies promotes insight into the viability of the various methodologies and instruments currently in use. Previous year's studies have looked at the growth of follicular units vs. microscope dissection vs. traditional micrografts; differences in graft preparation and insertion; new technologies vs. more traditional methods. The results from these studies will be presented at the ISHRS meeting in Hawaii in December, 2000. Practice management and marketing strategies will be presented. A specially-designed research program featuring the scientists in the hair loss field round out the program and provide a meaningful perspective.

It is the intent of the ISHRS and the WHS to continually improve upon this program and promote this practical form of education for the hair restoration community. We all look forward to seeing you at this year's Live Workshop in March and at the Annual Meeting in December.
