

arrives on my desk, and did Volume 3, No. 4, June-August 1993 issue arrive today.



In other words, if we as surgeons automati-

cally took a frontal, a profile, left and right obliques as well as a superior and posterior view, I think a better more precise evaluation of results could be obtained.

Thank you so much Dr. Norwood, for your continued and always wonderful presentations, and know



that I would like once and for all, to bring this issue of standardized photographs to the table at our next meeting in Toronto, September 8-11, 1994.
