She recently participated in the study "Combining Deep Learning with Optical Coherence Tomography Imaging to Determine Scalp Hair and Follicle Counts." This study may help us bring new strategies for better planning surgeries in the short and long term. I am looking forward to her presentation and learning how this can improve our practices.

This year we have received close to 100 abstracts, and I've been told that quality of abstracts has increased from previous years, so congratulations to all who submitted. The

committee is continuing their review, and soon I will begin planning scientific sessions to make your experience unforgettable. Editorial Guidelines for Submission and Acceptance of Articles for the Forum Publication

- Articles should be written with the intent of sharing scientific information with the purpose of advancing the art and science of hair restoration and improving patient outcomes.
- If results are presented, the medical regimen or surgical techniques that were used to obtain the results should be disclosed in detail. If intra-operative or immediate post-operative photos are presented, please submit photos that show results (at least 6 months after surgery) of the procedure being presented.
- Articles submitted with the sole purpose of promotion or 3. marketing will not be accepted.
- Authors should acknowledge all funding sources that 4. supported their work as well as any relevant corporate affiliation.
- 5. Trademarked names should not be used to refer to devices or techniques, when possible.
- Although we encourage submission of articles that may only 6. contain the author's opinion for the purpose of stimulating thought, the editors may present such articles to colleagues with experience in the area in question for the purpose of obtaining further opinions to be published alongside the original article. Occasionally, a manuscript might be sent to an external reviewer who will judge the manuscript in a blind fashion to make recommendations about its acceptance, further revision, or rejection.
- Once the manuscript is accepted, it will be published as 7. soon as possible, depending on space availability.
- All manuscripts should be submitted to forumeditors@ishrs.org. 8.
- An Author Authorization and Release form must be individually completed by every author listed on the byline and the Word document (not a fax) submitted at the time of article submission. The form can be obtained in the Members Only section of the ISHRS website at www.ishrs.org. This release is meant to be signed electronically directly in the Word document. 
