## Editorial Guidelines for Submission and Acceptance of Articles for the *Forum* Publication

- Articles should be written with the intent of sharing scientific information with the purpose of advancing the art and science of hair restoration and improving patient outcomes.
- If results are presented, the medical regimen or surgical techniques that were used to obtain the results should be disclosed in detail. If intra-operative or immediate post-operative photos are presented, please submit photos that show results (at least 6 months after surgery) of the procedure being presented.
- Articles submitted with the sole purpose of promotion or marketing will not be accepted.
- Authors must disclose all funding sources, relevant corporate affiliations, and any potential conflicts of interest within the manuscript.
- Trademarked names should not be used to refer to devices or techniques whenever possible.
- Opinion-based articles are welcome to stimulate discussion; however, such manuscripts may be reviewed by editors or external reviewers in a blinded manner, with additional expert commentary published alongside the article when appropriate. Additional recommendations may be made about its acceptance, further revision, or rejection.
- Once the manuscript is accepted, it will be published as soon as possible, depending on space availability.
- An *Author Authorization and Release Form* must be individually completed by each author listed on the byline, and the Word document (not a fax) submitted at the time of article submission. - All figures and tables should be sized down to no greater than 6 inches in width and sent as separate attachments to your email at the time of submission.
- All manuscripts, accompanying forms, and figures should be submitted together to [forumeditors@ishrs.org](mailto:forumeditors@ishrs.org).

**Authors must clearly disclose in the manuscript whether artificial intelligence (AI) tools were used in the writing process, specifying the nature of the assistance and the sections where such tools were applied.**
